主旨：有關外籍碩（博）士班學生申請擔任115學年度上學期
「外國學生TA教學獎助金」擔任教學獎助生，請協助轉
知並鼓勵學生踴躍參與，請查照。

說明：

一、依據「國立中興大學外國學位生獎學金實施辦法」辦理。

二、申請資訊如下：

(一)申請資格：本校外籍碩（博）士班學生（領取臺灣獎學金及教育部菁英留學獎學金、ICDF獎學金者除外）。

(二)申請方式：請學生於115年7月21日至7月27日晚間12時止至「國際事務處」英語網站(<https://oia.nchu.edu.tw/index.php/>)申請欲擔任教學獎助生之全英語授課課程（以教務處課務系統授課語言為準，課程人數不限），至多1門。

(三)若教師需要外籍學位生助教，但無適合人選，可於即日起至7月17日填寫線上表單(<https://forms.gle/9DMnRVH2irX7ghPa7>)，由本處協助將課程資訊轉達給學生；由學生自行投遞履歷，授課教師自行評估確認人選後，再由學生至國際處官網申

請。

(四)評選程序：由授課教師及國際事務處進行評選，於115年9月4日公佈評選結果，以一位老師一門課一位TA為原則。

(五)獎助名額：60名為上限，得不足額錄取。

三、獲獎生於學期開始後，需參加TA知能研習工作坊，並每週填報工作日誌，符合規定者每月核予獎助學金新臺幣5,000元(為期4個月)，並於學期末進行考核及頒發服務證書。

四、若申請人數超過60名，評選原則如下：

(一)第一順位：新生且沒有領取中興獎學金。

(二)第二順位：其他年級學生且沒有領取中興獎學金。

(三)第三順位：其他符合申請條件之學生，以選課人數較多之班別所需TA優先。

(四)惟該次核給結果剩餘名額達1/5以上時，經國際長同意核給開第二門課的老師屬意之優秀TA，仍依開順位比序擇優錄取，以鼓勵教師多開設全英語課程。

After instructor reviews and confirms the candidates, the selected student may proceed to apply through the OIA website.
