



Announcement of Prince of Songkla University

International Internship Inbound Scholarship Program for the Academic Year 2026

Prince of Songkla University has established a policy to promote experiential learning in conjunction with strengthening international academic collaboration networks. In accordance with this policy, the University has initiated the International Internship Scholarship (Inbound) program to provide opportunities for international students to undertake internships at Prince of Songkla University.

To ensure the effective and systematic implementation of the aforementioned scholarship program, the University hereby invites faculties and internal units to submit proposals for consideration for the allocation of scholarship quotas. The details and conditions are outlined as follows.

1. Terms and conditions for scholarship application:

1.1 Number, Value and Supporting Details of Scholarship

A maximum of twenty (20) partial scholarships will be awarded to international students, with a value of 20,000 Baht. The scholarship is provided as partial financial support; therefore, recipients are required to manage their budgets independently to cover all expenses incurred during the internship period at Prince of Songkla University.

The scholarship may be used to support expenses including, but not limited to, international airfare (economy class), accommodation, living allowance, health and accident insurance, and passport and visa fees.

1.2 Qualifications of Scholarship Recipients:

1.2.1 Scholarship recipients must be students from international universities who are currently enrolled in any field of study at the undergraduate or graduate level.

1.2.2 Scholarship recipients must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25 in the final semester prior to the application deadline, based on a 4.0 grading system. (A = 4.00, B+ = 3.50, B = 3.00, C+ = 2.50, C = 2.00, D = 1.50, E = 0).

1.2.3 Scholarship recipients must demonstrate good English communication skills.

Non-native English speakers are required to submit valid English proficiency test scores that meet the specified criteria. The test results must be no more than two years old as of the application date.

Type of Test	Required Score
1. TOEIC	At least 600
2. TOEFL iBT	At least 60
3. TOEFL CBT	At least 150
4. IELTS	At least 5.5

1.2.4 Scholarship recipients must have excellent physical and mental health, with no conditions that could impede their ability to perform work-related tasks.

1.2.5 Scholarship recipients must provide a confirmation letter from their home university.

1.2.6 Scholarship recipients must provide an internship topic and a confirmation letter from the relevant faculty or department at Prince of Songkla University.

1.3 Scholarship Conditions:

1.3.1 Scholarship Recipients must complete an internship of at least 6 weeks and register through the PSU NEXT-U system.

1.3.2 Failure to complete the required internship duration shall result in a full refund of the scholarship, except in cases of force majeure by the Education and Innovative Learning Academy (EILA).

1.3.3 A Student Internship Report must be submitted to the Education and Innovative Learning Academy (EILA) by 1 week of completion.
